



Yes, you **must** display your permit at all times when parking on any University car park. Failure to display a permit could result in a parking charge notice being issued

Can I register more than one car?

Yes, two permits will be issued which should be displayed in all registered vehicles (max 3). You must transfer the permit into the vehicle parking on any University car park.

Can I pay for car parking by cash anywhere on Campus: **No**

How can I pay if I don't have a mobile phone?

You can make payment using any type of phone. If you don't have access to any phones or a friend or colleague willing to pay on your behalf then unfortunately you may have to find alternative parking arrangements.

Do I need a modern phone? My phone does not have internet access or app facilities?

You can make payment using any type of phone ringing Telephone No. 0161 880 0100 and make the relevant payment to the operator

I'm just visiting the University for the day and do NOT wish to register on-line of the paybyphone app as I may never require this service again

How long do I have to pay/obtain a permit before I am likely to receive a Parking Charge Notice?

You must pay as soon as you enter the car park and have parked up.

Once I have paid for parking can I move from one car parking to another?

Yes providing it is of the same tariff

Does buying a permit guarantee me a space?

It will not guarantee a space on the car park of your choice, but there are usually sufficient spaces across the University Campus to meet customer demands

I have received a Parking Charge Notice and I wish to appeal.
